No longer is there a need for separation periods, unfaithfulness (adultery) or unreasonable behaviour.

Instead, either person now needs to simply state that there is an 'irretrievable break-down of the marriage'. In other words, the marriage is at an end.

Either person or both jointly can start a divorce following the law changes made in April 2022.
